Unit 2.1 God's Chosen People

Chosen by God

People chosen to do special tasks by God. They were trusted to do the right thing.

Abraham

Abraham was the first person to teach the idea that there was only one God. God chose him and his wife Sarah to go on a long journey. God promised Abraham he would always be with him.

Moses

Moses was chosen by God. He was put in the River Nile in a basket as a baby. When he was older he saved the slaves from Egypt.

Daniel

Daniel was chosen by God. He prayed to God every day. When he was thrown into the lion's den, an angel came to save him.

Trust

A feeling that someone or something won't let you down.

Faith

Complete trust in somebody or something (e.g. God) even when things get hard.

Bravery

To do the right thing even though it might be scary.

Slaves

A person who is owned by someone and forced to work with no pay or rights.

Key Questions

- What does 'chosen' mean?
- Why do you think God choose people? What does he choose them for?
- How did Abraham show he trusted God?

Abraham is renamed Abraham: a father of many nations Genesis 17: 1-8
The Hebrew people live as slaves in Egypt Exodus 1: 8-22
Moses found by Pharaoh's daughter Exodus 2: 1-10
Daniel in the Lions' Den Daniel 6: 1-23, 26
